







Start by thinking of all the wierd and wonderful fish. They come in a huge variety of different shapes and sizes with all kinds of patterns and colours.

If you can, do some research in books or online, or you can invent your own fantastic fish!





Try varying the size of your patterns and see how many you can come up with.








